

HOW TO MAKE A WINDSOCK FROM A PLASTIC BOTTLE

To make the "windsock" you will need:

- 16 oz. plastic water bottles (you can use whatever size you can get)
- Cloth ribbons
- Scotch tape
- Cutting tool
- String
- Hole punch

Take the water bottle and remove the label, then cut the top and bottom from it. You will be left with the center.

Using the hole punch, punch two holes across from each other at the top of this piece. You will put string through this end of it so that you can hang the windsock.

At the other end, punch four holes across from each other at the bottom of this piece. Ribbons are put through these holes, tied on, and they are the streamer portion of the windsock. Very easy!

Cloth ribbons (instead of metallic type) work best because they catch the breeze. You can also use ribbon to hang the windsock. The ribbon should be cut in 18" pieces, put half of the length of the ribbon through the hole, then tie it to fasten. That way you get double streamers.

If you do this at a school, be sure to use the school colors.
