## What to do if a fluorescent bulb breaks:

Close off the room to other parts of the building. Open a window to disperse vapor and leave the room for at least 15 minutes. Wear disposable gloves. Scoop fragments with stiff paper and wipe area with a damp disposable paper towel to remove glass fragments. All fragments should be disposed of in a sealed plastic bag. Tape can be used to pick up small pieces and powder. Do not use a standard vacuum cleaner. Avoid generating dust. The first time you vacuum, remove the bag, and dispose in 2 sealed plastic bags.
